Black Horse Balance, 20 kg

Black Horse Balance is an oat free basic fodder for all horses. Balance is given as a supplement with normal hay feed. Thanks to its versatile and balanced composition, it is suitable for all kind of horses as the exclusive concentrate feed, especially for horses to whom the oat feed is not preferable.



Recommended dosing:

Horses in intense work 3 – 5 kg/day
Horses in medium work 2 - 3 kg/day
Ponies (depending on size and intensity of work) 0,5 - 2 kg/day
Mares
At the late pregnancy (9-11 months) *
1 - 3 kg/day
Lactating mares *2,5 - 4 kg/day
Young growing horses *1,5 - 2,5 kg/day

*Protein supplement is recommended for lactating mares and foals.

Weight per litre appr. 700 g

Crude protein: 12,0 %
ME: 13,1 MJ/kg dm

Black Horse Classic+, 20 kg

Black Horse Classic+ is a basic fodder for all horses based on finnish high quality oat. Low sugar and starch content. Classic is given as a supplement with normal hay feed. Thanks to its versatile and balanced composition, it is suitable for horses as the exclusive concentrate feed. Classic+ contains MOS (mannan-oligosaccharide). MOS binds the harmful bacteria of the intestinal tract reducing the colonization on the gut wall. MOS is able to stimulate the growth and activity of beneficial bacteria in the intestinal tract.



Recommended dosing:

Horses in intense work 3 - 5 kg/day
Horses in medium work 2 - 3 kg/day
Ponies (depending on size and intensity of work) 0,5 - 2,5 kg/day
Mares
At the late pregnancy (9-11 months) *1,5 - 2,5 kg/day
Lactating mares *2,0 - 3,0 kg/day
Young growing horses *1,5 - 2,5 kg/day

* extra mineral / protein if needed

Black Horse Tender, 20 kg

Complementary feed for horses and ponies
Black Horse Tender - for sensitive stomach. Black Horse Tender is a complementary feed low in sugar (5%) and starch (5%) for horses and ponies. Tender is given as a supplement with normal hay feed. Due to the carefully selected raw materials guarantee the tasty taste of Tender. Thanks to its versatile and balanced composition, it is suitable for horses as the exclusive concentrate feed. Trace elements (Se, Fe, Mn, Zn and Cu) are also added as well absorbing chelates of amino acids and fumarate.

Black Horse Tender is a fiber rich feed which is suitable to lower the starch income for horses with sensitive stomach. Tender contains mannan-oligosaccharides (MOS) and herbal product (OrigoStim).



Recommended dosing:

Horses in intense work (weight 500 kg)
3,0 - 5,0 kg (5,0 - 8,3 litres)/day
Horses in medium work (weight 500 kg)
2,0- 3,0 kg (3,3 - 5,0 litres)/day
Ponies (depending on size and intensity of work)
0,3- 2,0 kg (0,5 - 3,3 litres)/day

Weight per litre appr. 600 g

Crude protein: 12,0 %
ME: 10,0 MJ/kg dm

Black Horse Harmny Mix. 20 kg

Harmoy Mix is a balanced muesli feed for horses and ponies. Due to its balanced composition the product can be given as a supplement to hay for feeding. It is especially beneficial if oat is not suitable for the horse. HARMONY mix complementary feed contains minerals and trace elements as well as vitamins and therefore separate minerals are not needed.

Black Horse Harmony Mix is used as a supplement to normal hay feed. The feed can be used dry or moistened. The amount fed should be adjusted according to the size of the horse and the work load. The daily amount should be divided into several feeds.



Recommended dosing:

Horses in hard work 3 – 5 kg/day
Horses in medium work 2 - 3 kg/day
Ponies 1 – 2 kg/day

Weight per litre appr. 550 g.

Crude protein: 11,5 %
ME: 11,5 MJ/kg dm

Black Horse Start Up, 20 kg

Complementary Feed for weaned foals!

The Black Horse Start Up supplements the basic nutrition of the foals and ensures the need of the essential minerals, trace elements, vitamins and amino acids (amino acids are the building blocks of protein). Due to the carefully selected raw materials guarantee the digestibility and tasty taste of the feed. Trace elements (Se, Fe, Mn, Zn and Cu) are also added as well absorbing chelates of amino acids and fumarate. The feed contains also MOS (mannan-oligosaccharide). The foal should get used to eat feed and eat from its own bucket in advance of weaning. The amount of feed is gradually increased, depending the time of weaning, until the wanted feed ration is reached. Feeding the Start Up begins when the foal is still with the mare and continues until about one year of age.



Recommended amount (550 kg weight as an adult):

Foals (3-6 months) 1-2 kg / day prior to weaning,
the foal should be accustomed to eating the feed
Weaned foals (6-12 months) 2-3 kg / day

Start Up feed can be served as it is, it can also be
moisten. Feeding hay free.

Black Horse Breeder, 20 kg -protein supplement!

Black Horse Breeder is a protein supplement with added value amino acids lysine and methionine. Protein is a vital requirement for all horses, the demand is greatest for the growing horses and the late trimester/lactating mares.

Roughages are important components of horse's diet. They can vary extremely in their protein content. Breeder is also suitable for meet protein needs of all horses if for example its content of roughages is low.



Dosage recommendation depending on
other feeding:

Sporhorses 0,25 kg/day

Mares

At the late pregnancy (9-11 months) 0,5
kg/day

Lactating mares 0,5 – 1,0 kg/day

Foals 0,5 kg/day

Weight per litre appr. 700 g

Crude protein: 30,0 %
ME: 11,5 MJ/kg dm

During the first months of life, the foal's main food is mare's milk. As the lactation progresses, the foal begins to eat more and more concentrated feed. Concentrated feeds can be given to about a one month old foal, usually the foal eats a part of the mare's ration. The growth of the foal should also be monitored to see if it is energetic, has shiny coat. Obesity or thinness is not good for the foal, or too rapid growth. In addition to proper feeding, the foal also needs a considerable amount of regular, free exercise to develop to a durable, agile and fast horse.
