NOTES & GUIDELINES

An IHRA Stallion Licence will only be considered for a horse that is:

- A Full Bred Standardbred Horse
- Parentally Verified to both Sire & Dam by DNA analysis
- Three years of age or older

ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION (Fresh, Chilled or Frozen)

If you intend to collect semen from your Stallion to be used for AI purposes (fresh, chilled or frozen) the Stallion will require to be tested for Contagious Equine Metritis (CEM), Equine Infectious Anaemia (EIA) and Equine Viral Arteritis (EVA).

Confirmation of Negative results must be submitted with this application. In the case of a seropositive EVA result following vaccination, evidence of a negative result prior to vaccination is required

It is advisable to obtain a copy of the AI regulations from the IHRA

Please Note: IHRA Covering Certificates will only be issued to Licensed Stallions, retrospective Covering Certificates for Stallions unlicensed at the time of covering will be subject to penalty at the discretion of the IHRA
